Dear Parents and Carers,

With just one week left until the Year 5 trip to the National Space Centre in Leicester, I wanted to share with you the important information for the trip.

There are two classes going on each day; please see below for confirmation of when your child's class is attending:

Monday 8th June classes 5C and 5L

Wednesday 10th June classes 5A and 5N

Thursday 11th June classes 5M and 5R

Itinerary for the day

Please arrive at school at the normal time. Pupils should go to their form room as normal to be registered and then head to the playground before boarding the coach. We plan to depart Alameda at 9:00am.

We aim to arrive at the National Space Centre in Leicester by 10:20am.

Our time will be split between three activities: free time to explore the centre and the gift shop, a premium viewing in the Sir Patrick Moore planetarium and a 30 minute live interactive science show.

The children will be split into groups and will always have an adult with them.

For their visit to the gift shop, we suggest a **limit of £10** for each pupil. Please put their money in a sealed envelope, with their name and form written on the front. This will be handed to your child's form tutor on arrival at school and looked after by their group leader until it's time for them visit the gift shop.

We will depart the National Space Centre at 3pm and aim to be back at the turning circle at 4:30pm. Your child will need to be collected unless you have given consent for them to walk home via the Scopay form.

Every pupil will need to bring a packed lunch to be eaten in a specified lunch area at the Space Centre. If your child is in receipt of free school meals, they will be provided with a packed lunch from the school kitchen.
