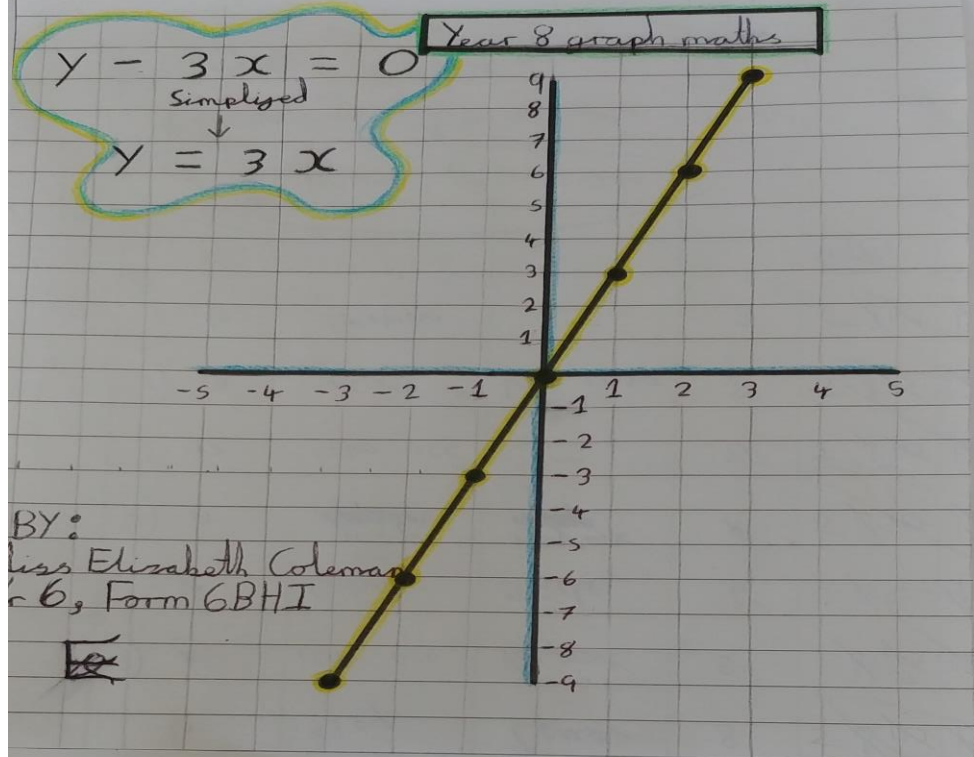

Law and order

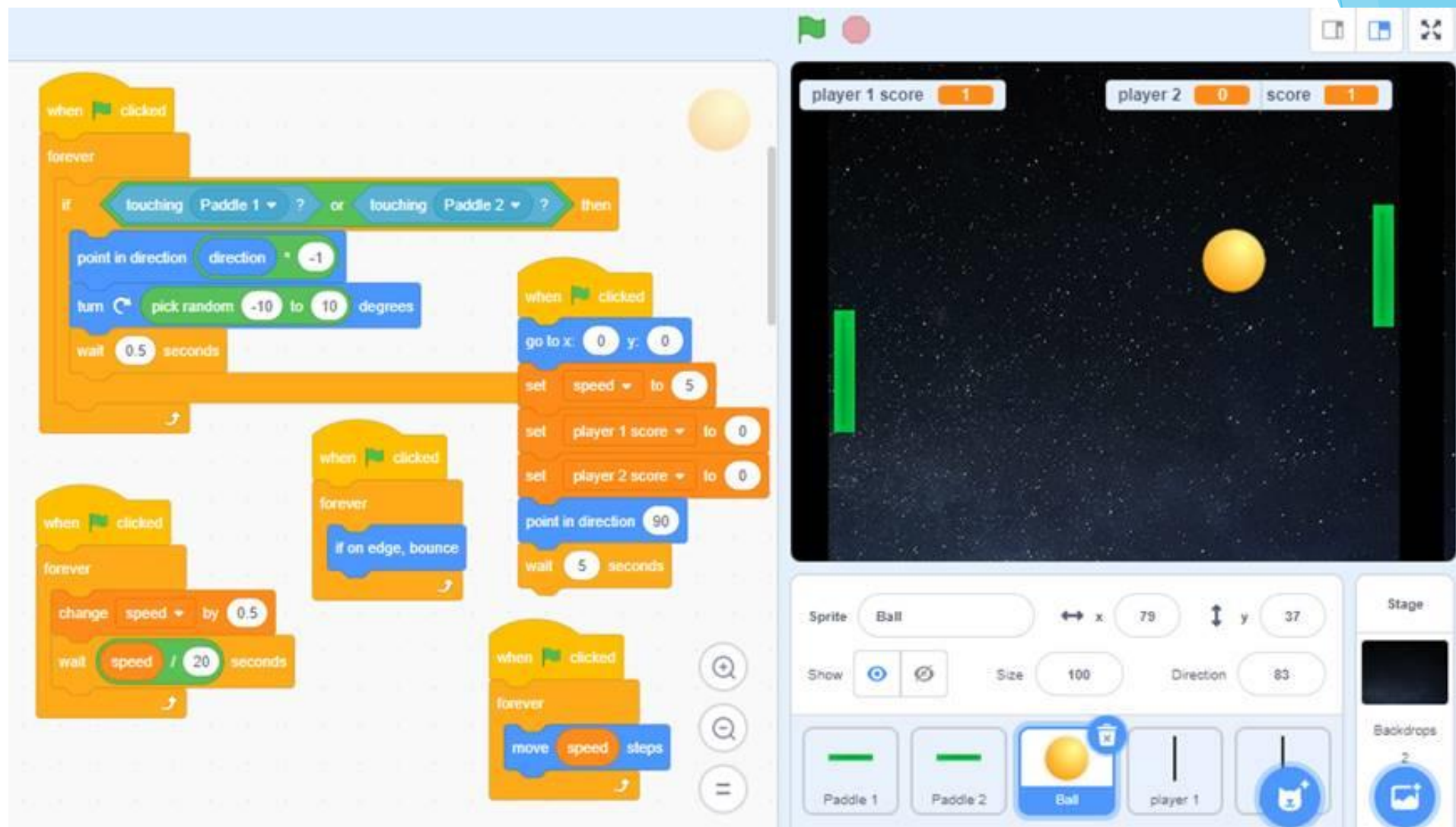
There is Law and order in the Palace but there is none in the forest.

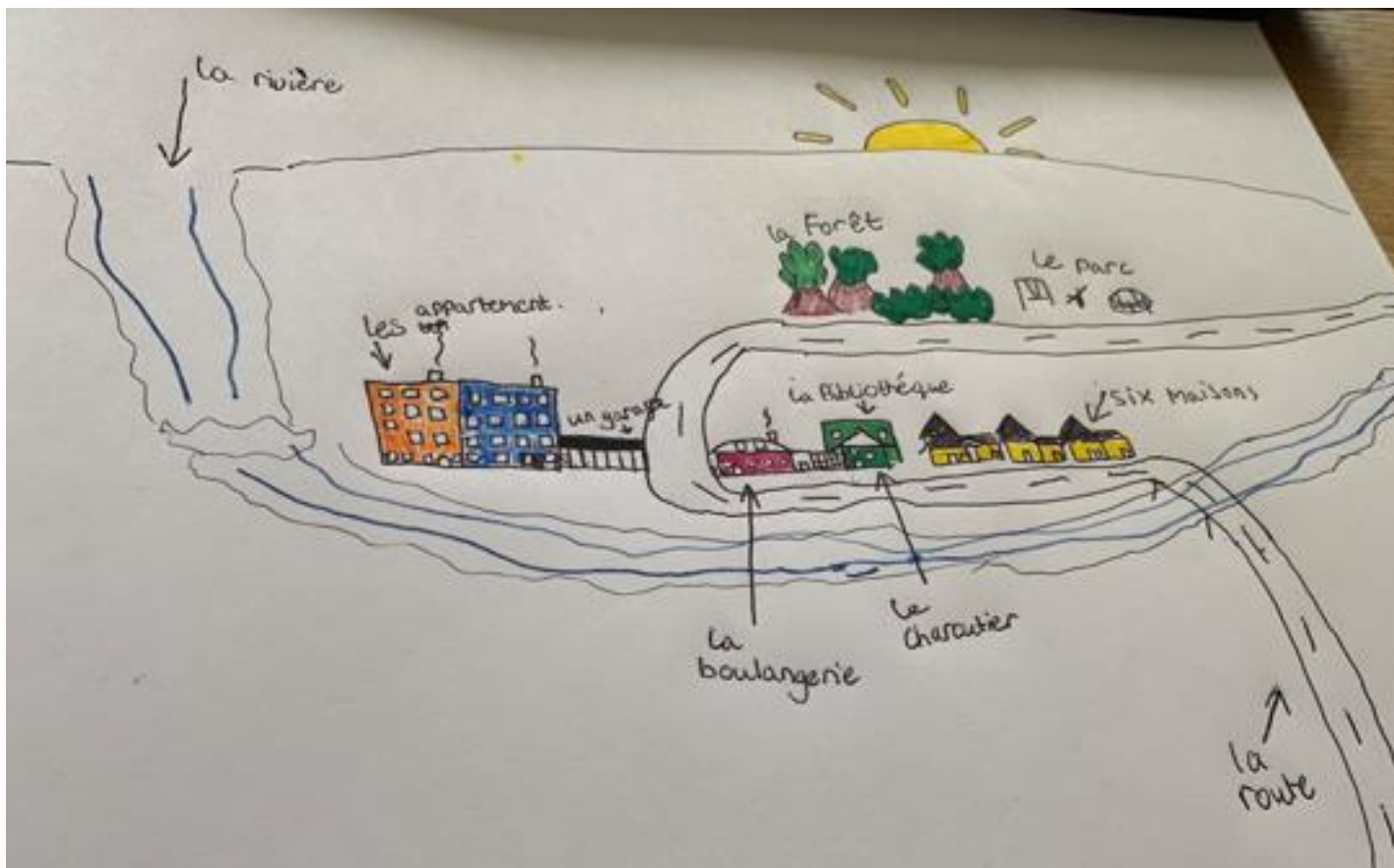
Disorder in the forest. The King and Queen of the fairies are fighting over a boy. Their fight leads to the natural order – season – being out of balance too.

Grammaire

When you look up a verb in the dictionary you find the infinitive form. Most French infinitives end in -er. The ending on the infinitive changes according to the subject of the verb, i.e. who is doing the action:

chanter = to sing	je chante	I sing / I am singing
	tu chantes	You sing / You are singing
	il/elle chante	He/she sings / He/she is singing
	on chante	We sing / are singing

Notice how in English je chante means both 'I sing' and 'I am singing'. There is only one form of the present tense in French.

What is VE Day?



- VE Day stands for Victory in Europe day.
- Adolf Hitler committed suicide on 30th April 1945. His named successor was Grand Admiral Karl Donitz. During his brief time as Germany's president, Donitz negotiated an end to the on 4yhwar with the Allies.
- A German Delegation was sent to the Headquarters of British Field Marshall, Bernard Montgomery at Luneburg Heath, east of Hamburg, on 4th May.
- Montgomery accepted the unconditional surrender of German Forces.
- The document was signed on behalf of Germany by General Alfred Jodle and came into effect the following day.



When and Where was it celebrated?

May 8th 1945 was the date the Allies celebrated the defeat of Nazi Germany. People celebrate VE Day in lots of different countries, but not all countries celebrate on May 8th like we do. This is because the instrument of surrender signed on May 7th specified that all hostilities would cease at 23:01 Berlin Time on May 8th and, as time in Moscow was an hour ahead, this would push the ceasefire into May 9th.

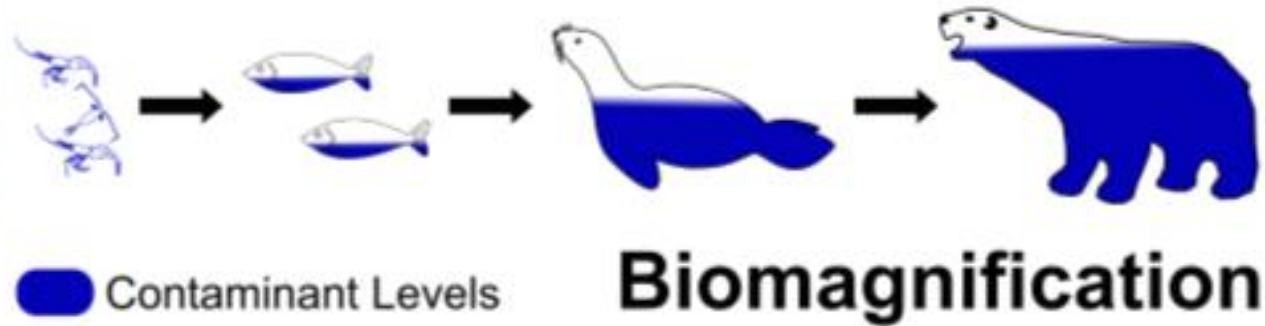
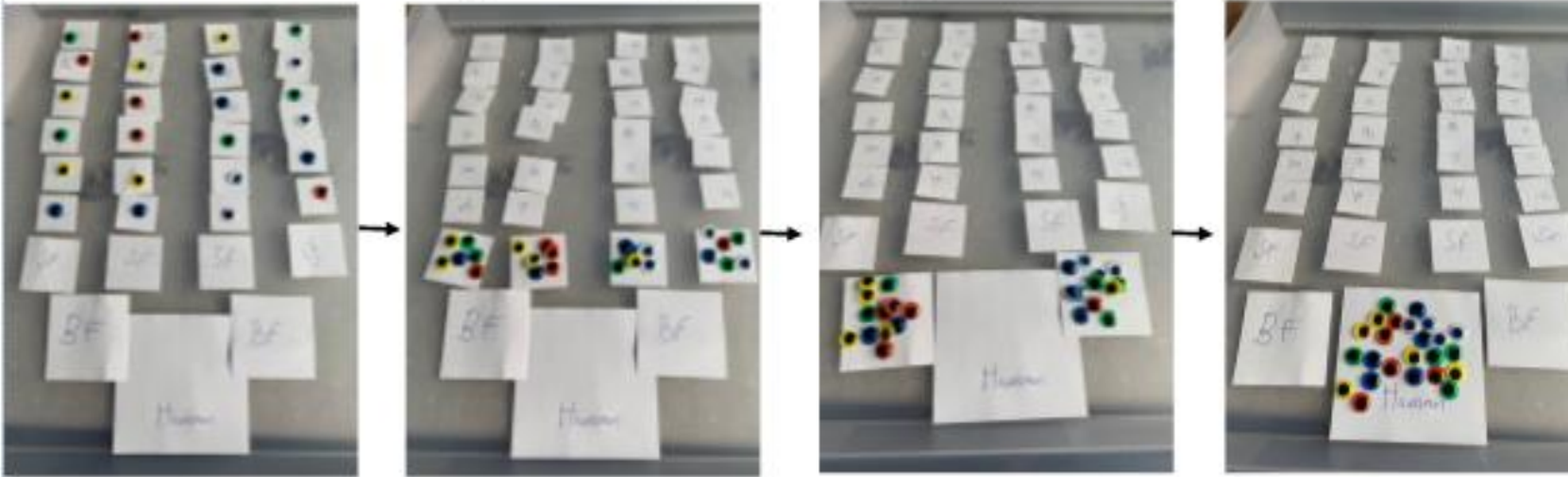

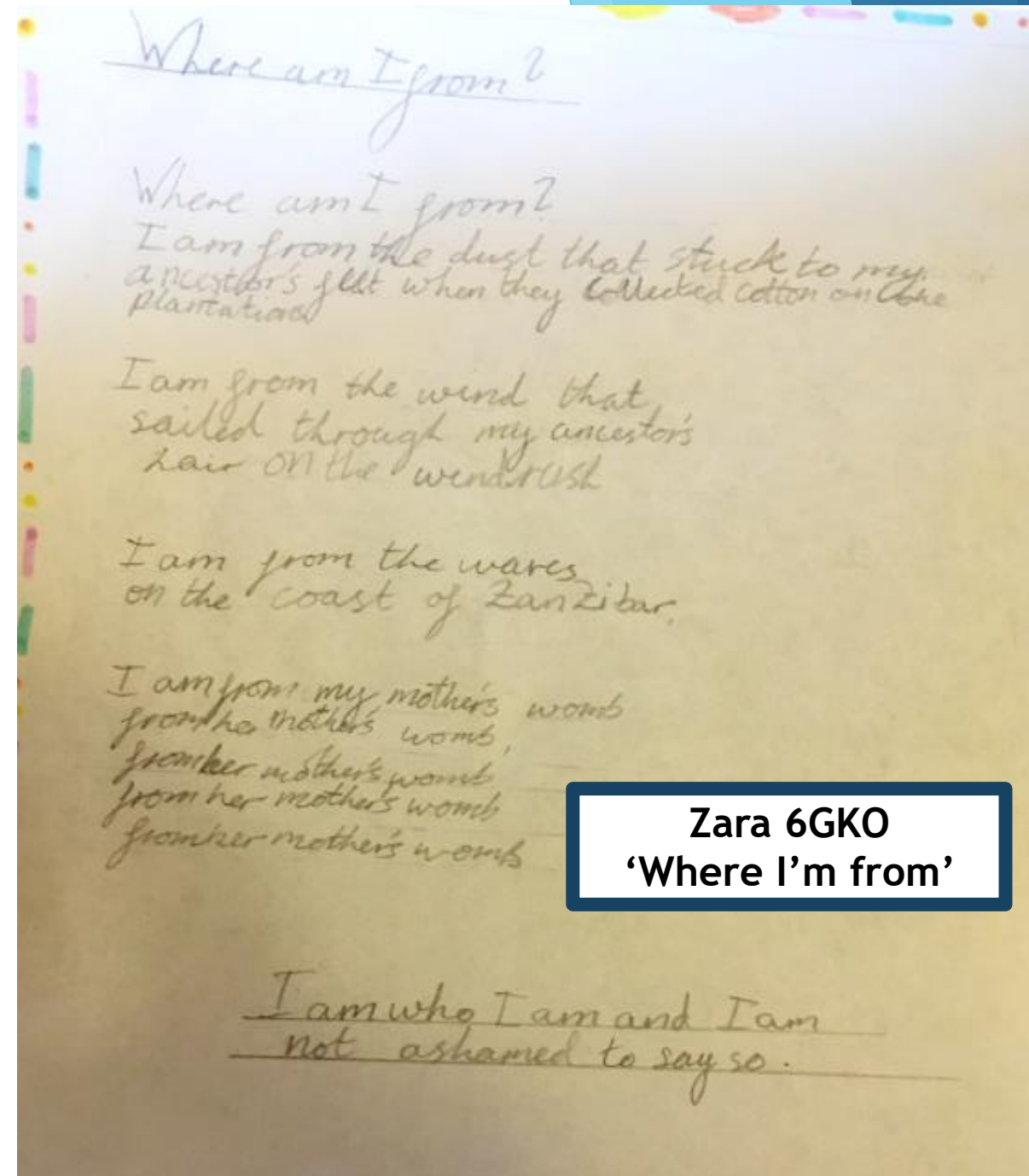
I'm from a difficult start in life, born six weeks early

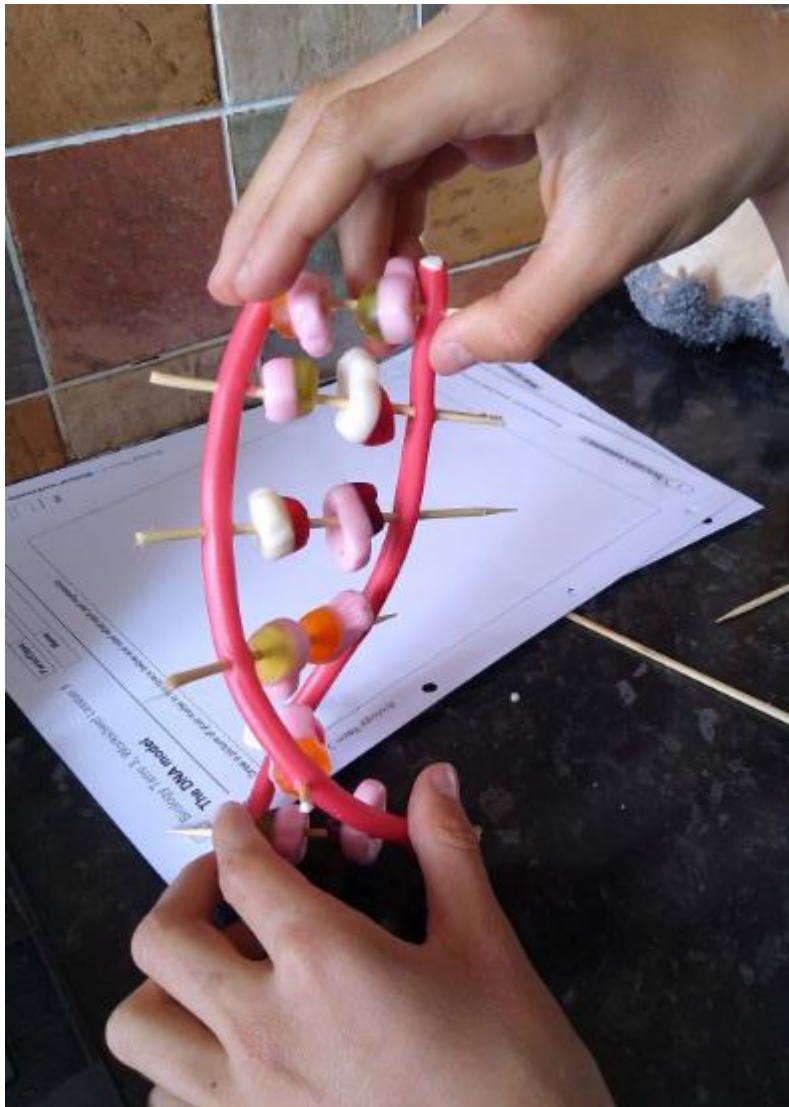

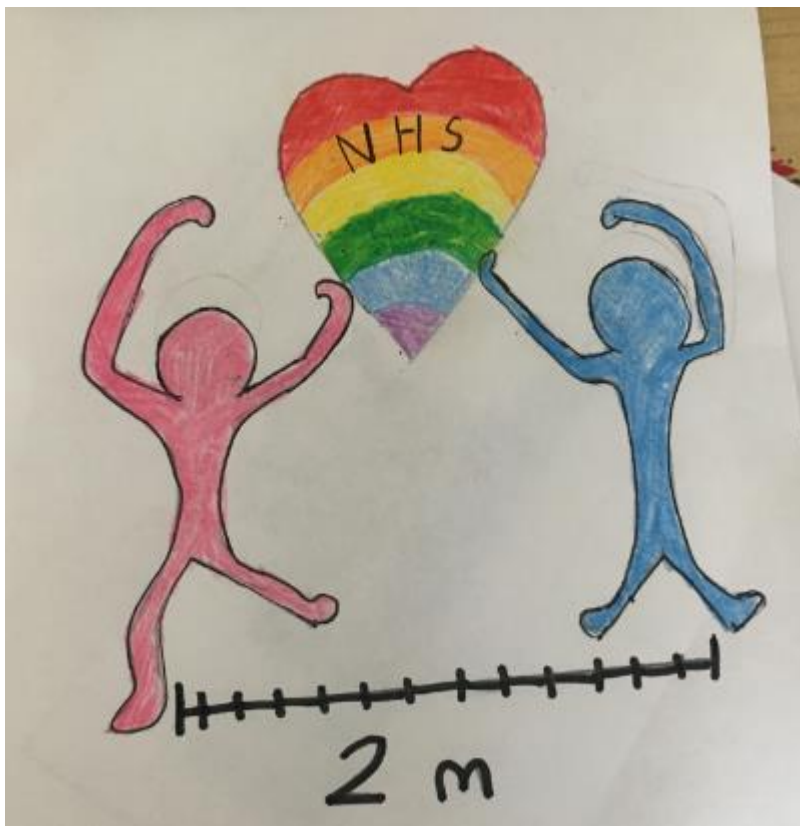

 The steps of natural selection:
 1. There is a variation in a population of organisms.
 2. This variation means that some organisms in the population are better adapted to their environment.
 3. The organisms that are better adapted survive to become adults.
 4. They reproduce and pass on the genes for adaptations to their children.
 5. Over time the population changes, or evolves.
 Polar bears are thought to have evolved from bears with brown fur. Polar bears use their white fur to camouflage them from their prey so they can creep up and catch them without being seen.
