Introductory Activity

Students should be given the [Descriptive Imagery Sheet](#), which is differentiated for LA, MA and HA. Students' perceptions from the activity should be discussed and defined as a class.

A Winter Dawn

As a class, read through the poem. Students should use the [At a Glance](#) activity sheet to note down any initial ideas or discussion.

Students should be given the [Analysis Cards](#) which are differentiated for LA, MA and HA. These could be completed in pairs or groups.

Moving On Activity

Students should be given the [Moving On Activity Sheet](#), differentiated for LA, MA and HA. These give an alternative image for students to collect their own thoughts and understanding on, which could lead them to writing their own poems if time permits.

Extended Learning

- Research the poet.
- Read and analyse another poem by the poet.
- Draw an image to represent the poem.
- Write a paragraph describing the scene using descriptive language.
